For example, a class on having a baby would be under the category of Nursing or Biology, or if you however enjoy writing about personalities and human behaviors, these topics could fit into a Social Psychology or Sociology at University.

Social issues

Relationships, Behavior, Personalities, Choices, Jobs

Global issues

Laws, Culture, Racial Differences, Economics, Governments

Film studies

Foreign TV, Analysis of Films

Country Studies

Analysis of cultural differences between specific countries

Universities

Foreign Universities, different types of entrance exams

Writing is the main skill for this course but you will be asked to research your topics and design multimedia versions of your writing results, and give presentations.

Points are earned by:

1. Discussing your work in English in Class
2. Written work turned in
3. Term projects (3-4 projects)
4. An Oral preparation test for University interviews
