- What has been your major achievement or success?
- How have you changed over the last three years?
- Tell me how you solved some problems over the past three years.

*What are you doing at your High School at the moment?*

- What motivates you?
- What are you currently studying?

- How would your teacher describe your work and attitude?
- How would a friend describe you?
- What area of your studying do you think you need to improve?
- What are your leisure time activities?
